

## Rejoice

## Philippians 4:4

"Rejoice in the LORD always again I will say Rejoice".

When you are eagerly waiting for your friend to arrive, do you wait for him to first arrive and then be happy??? No... As soon as you get to know that your friend is visiting you, there is a joy within.. similarly, when the Dr confirms the lady, that she is going to enter motherhood, the joy starts from within...
