1	Who wrote Acts of Apostles	Luke
2	Which apostle dominates in this book	Chapter 1 - 12 Peter dominates Chapter 13 - 28 Paul dominates
3	Name the person to whom this book is addressed to	Theophilus
4	How many days Jesus was seen after resurrection	40 days
5	How Jesus ascended to heaven	While talking to disciples He was taken up and a cloud received Him out of their sight
6	What promise the angel proclaimed	Two men in white apparel said” this same Jesus who was taken up from you in to heaven will come in like manner as you saw Him go in to heaven
7	How deciles waited for receiving the Holy Spirit.	In the upper room they continued in prayer in one accord
8	Who was chosen in place of Judas Iscariot	Matthias
9	Day of Pentecost reminds which Old Testament day	It represents 50 <sup>th</sup> day after Passover festival. It also coincides with the 50 <sup>th</sup> day after deliverance from Egypt when they received Law from Moses in Mount Sinai
10	How many people got saved hearing the Peter’s speech at Pentecost after receiving Holy Spirit.	3000 people got saved hearing the gospel by Peter on Pentecost day.
11	How many people got killed when the LAW was given at Mount Sinai	3000 people got perished when the Law was given at mount Sinai.
12	What was the sign when Holy Spirit came and filled the Disciples	They spoke in Tongues. When Peter spoke in Tongues, everyone understood in their own language.
13	What did Peter explain	Peter explained that the Holy Spirits filling is the fulfillment of God’s promise in “Joel’s prophecy” of Old Testament.

14	Convicted by Holy Spirit, people asked Peter “what shall we do”. What did Peter reply	Repent. And be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ, then you shall receive the Holy Spirit.
15	How the first congregation continue	They prayed together in the temple, ate together breaking bread in houses.
16	At the beautiful gate when the lame man begged what did Peter reply	Silver and gold I do not have. In the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth rise up and walk. He got healed instantly. He praised God.
17	Why Peter & John were put in prison	The Jews did not like them preaching in the name of Jesus whom they crucified.
18	How the first believers considered their possessions	They considered their possessions as common. They sold their land and brought the money to Apostles
19	What happened to Ananias & Sapphira	They sold their land. But kept some money for themselves and lied to Apostles. Both Ananias & Sapphira died falling down in front of Apostles.
20	Explain the miracles done through Apostles	Healing of all diseases & demon possessions. People brought and laid their sick people on the street to have the shade of Peter fall on them.
21	How many persons were selected to serve on the table for the congregation	Seven men full of holy spirit were selected. Stephen was one of them.
22	What happened to Stephen	God permitted lot of miracles through Stephen. The Jews plotted against him, brought false witnesses to the Council, which resulted in stoning him to death.
23	While stoning what did Stephen see	He saw heaven opened and saw the glory of God. He saw Jesus standing by the right hand side of God.
24	What is the specialty of chapter 7	Stephen full of Holy Spirit spoke to the council explaining the gospel, quoting from Old Testament
25	What did the person called Saul did	Saul consented to death of Stephen. He entered every house of “believers in Jesus” dragging off them to prison.
26	Who went to Samaria preaching the gospel and what happened there	In Samaria many believed in Jesus. Lot of miracles and healing took place there. There was great joy in the city.

27	Who went to Samaria to see the revival & what happened there	Peter & John went to Samaria, prayed with them, laid hands on the believers to receive the Holy Spirit.
28	How the gospel was sent to Ethiopia	Philip preached Gospel to Ethiopian Queen's servant. He received Jesus, and got baptized on his way back to Ethiopia from Jerusalem.
29	What is specialty of Chapter 9	Saul who persecuted church got saved on his way to Damascus.
30	How Saul got saved	Nearing Damascus, a great light was shown around him from heaven. He fell down and heard a voice "why are you persecuting me" Saul asked "Who are you Lord" Lord said "I am Jesus whom you persecute". Jesus sent a disciple Ananias to pray for him and he accepted Lord Jesus as savior.
31	What did Saul do in Damascus.	He preached with strength in Damascus proving to Jews that "Jesus is Christ" their Messiah. The Jews plotted to kill him.
32	How Saul escaped from Damascus	The disciples let him down in a basket through the wall. He left for Jerusalem.
33	What happened to Saul in Jerusalem	Barnabas took him to Apostles. He spoke boldly in the name of Jesus. But the Jews attempted to kill him. So he was sent to Caesarea and then to Tarsus.
34	What miracles did happen in Lydda & Joppa through apostle Peter	Eight years Paralyzed man Aeneas got healed in Lydda God raised Tabitha from death in Joppa
35	What was the vision Peter got in Joppa	Peter was hungry and fell in to a trance. He saw a vision of all animals in a sheet bound at corners in front of him. A voice said "Rise, Peter, kill and eat" Peter said "I have never eaten anything common or unclean. A voice again said " What God has cleansed you must not call common"

36	<b>What was the meaning of this vision and what happened</b>	<b>A Roman Centurion Cornelius had a heavenly vision asking him to send for Peter. The men Cornelius sent came to Joppa asking Peter to come to Caesarea. Peter understood from the vision that God wants him to preach the gospel to gentiles. So he went to Caesarea and preached the gospel. The gentiles received Holy Spirit. They all believed in Jesus Christ and got baptized.</b>
37	<b>What was the miracle in Antioch</b>	<b>Gentiles came to the Lord in large numbers. The church experienced great revival in Antioch.</b>
38	<b>Who was sent from Jerusalem to see the miracle of Antioch</b>	<b>Barnabas</b>
39	<b>What did Barnabas do after visiting Antioch</b>	<b>Barnabas went to tarsus to search for Saul. He found him and brought him to Antioch, and worshipped together.</b>
40	<b>What new name the believers got</b>	<b>The believers got the name “ Christians” in Antioch.</b>
