SL	Question	Answer
1	Identify The disciple killed by Herod	James (Brother of Apostle John)
2	Herod put Peter in Prison. What happened there	God sent His angel to prison to deliver Peter from the prison to safety in the night.
3	How Herod died	The people of Tire & Sidon shouted hearing Herod's voice "the voice of a god and not the voice of a man". Immediately the angel of Lord struck him, because he did not give glory to God. Herod was eaten by worms and died.
4	What happened when the church in Antioch fasted and prayed.	Holy Spirit said "separate Barnabas & Saul for the missionary work. They laid hands on them and sent them for Lord's work.
5	How many places Saul (Paul) and Barnabas travelled and preached the Gospel, during First Missionary Journey.	Antioch(Syria), Seleucia, Salamis (Cyprus), Paphos, Perga, Attalia, Antioch (Pisidia) Iconium, Lystra, Derbe, Antioch.
6	What happened when Paul was preaching to Proconsul Sergius Paulus.	Elimas (Bar_ Jesus) the sorcerer opposed Paul and stood against them. Paul filled with Holy Spirit rebuked him and he became blind.
7	What happened in Antioch(Pisidia)	The people were keenly listening to Paul and many believed. But, seeing the crowd, the Jews filled with jealousy abused them. Paul and Barnabas boldly answered them. Since you reject the Gospel, now we turn to gentiles.
8	What happened in Iconium	Many Jews and gentiles believed in Jesus. Many miracles happened. But opposition grew and they plotted to kill Paul and Barnabas.
9	What miracle happened in Lystra & Derbe	While Paul was preaching a lame man got healed. Seeing that miracle, the people brought sacrifices considering Paul and Barnabas as their gods. Paul told them they are human being just like them.
10	How opposition grew in Lystra & Derbe	The Jews came from Antioch (Pisidia) and Iconium and gathered people against Paul and Barnabas and stoned them. Later they returned to Antioch(Syria)
11	Jerusalem Council – What you know about it	Paul & Barnabas were sent to Jerusalem to meet the Apostle and elders to take decision on whether to insist gentile believers to follow Jewish customs and rituals. It was decided not to put such burden on the gentiles. God has purified everyone who believes in Jesus Christ without the need to follow Jewish customs.

12	Who travelled with Paul in Second Missionary Journey	Barnabas wanted to take Mark(John). But Paul did not agree because Mark left them in Perga during their first journey. Paul took Silas and started second missionary journey. Barnabas took Mark and travelled separately.
13	How many places Paul preached Gospel in second missionary journey	Syria, Celicia, Derbe, Lystrs, Antioch(Pisidia), Troas, Neapolis, Philippi, Amphipolis, Appallonia, Thessalonica, Berea, Athens, Corinth, Ephesus, Rhodes, Caesaria, Jerusalem, Antioch(Syria)
14	Who joined Paul & Silas in Derbe.	Thimothy. He was a believer. His mother was a believer from Jew and father was a Greek.
15	What vision Paul saw during this journey	Paul was prevented by Holy Spirit from preaching in the province of Asia. In the dream, Paul saw a man of Macedonia standing and begging "COME TO MACEDONIA AND HELP US". Paul took it as a word from God to go to Macedonia, (Greece, Europe).
16	Who was the first convert from Europe	Lydia. She was a business woman, a dealer in purple cloth from Thyatira. She believed and she invited Paul to stay in her house.
17	How Paul & Silas were put in prison	The fortune teller girl was delivered from the evil spirit through Paul and her managers lost the business. They complained and the authorities put Paul & Silas in prison.
18	What happened in the night in Prison	Paul & Silas sang and praised God. The foundations of Prison shook. The chains came loose. Doors opened. Seeing this thinking that the prisoners escaped the jailor wanted to kill himself. But Paul stopped it. Later he and family accepted Jesus Christ as saviour
19	What happened in Thessalonica	Many Jews and gentiles believed in Lord Jesus Christ and joined the church. But being jealous, the Jews created trouble to Jason and some brothers. So Paul had to leave the city in the night.
20	What happened in Berea	Many people accepted Jesus as savior. The people of Berea were very keen in searching the scriptures thoroughly. Jews from Thessalonica came here also and created trouble. Paul left alone to Athens.
21	What happened in Athens	Paul remained alone in Athens. Athens was full of idols. He saw an alter where it was written "TO THE UNKNOWN GOD". Paul used this opportunity to speak about Jesus. Some people believed. Some ignored.
22	What happened in Corinth	Paul met Aquila & Priscilla. They came from Rome as ordered by Emperor Claudius to all Jews to leave Rome. Silas & Timothy joined Paul here. In spite of opposition

		from Jews, God strengthened Paul to continue and serve the believers.
23	What happened in Ephesus	<p>The believers in Ephesus were filled with Holy Spirit under Paul's ministry. He stayed more time in Ephesus teaching. Many miracles took place through Paul's preaching. Many believed in Lord Jesus Christ.</p> <p>But trouble also started from silver smiths who lost business because nobody wanted idols.</p> <p>Later on Paul left for Jerusalem, via Macedonia. Then returned to Antioch. (Acts 18.22)</p>
24	Paul's third Missionary Journey	Paul started from Antioch passing through inner areas reached Ephesus. He went to Macedonia. Troas, Assos, Mitelene, Kios, samos, Milethos, Cos, Rhodes, Patara, Sore, Tyre, Jerusalem
25	What happened to Paul in Jerusalem	<p>Paul was arrested as the Jews stirred up the crowd against Paul.</p> <p>Paul was brought in front of Senhedrin, where he explained his faith.</p> <p>The Jews plotted to kill him in Jerusalem. Knowing that Paul was transferred to Caisarea.</p>
26	Where Paul stood under trial in Caisarea	<p>Roman Governor Felix</p> <p>After that Governor Festus</p> <p>Later King Agrippa</p>
27	Why Paul appealed to Ceaser	Governor Festus asked Paul to go to Jerusalem to stand trial. Paul did not accept that. He appealed to Ceaser as he was a Roman citizen.
28	How many people were with Paul in the ship to Rome	276 people, most of them were prisoners
29	What happened to the ship	Because of violent Storm the journey was in trouble. The ship was left in the sea without seeing Sun or Moon for several days. Finally the ship was totally damaged hitting against rock at a place called Malta.
30	Was Paul saved	Paul was saved. The entire passengers were saved. God sent His angel to Paul to strengthen him.
30	Did Paul reach Rome	Yes. Paul was brought to Rome as a prisoner, waiting for Trial by Ceaser.
31	Could Paul preach in Rome	Yes. He was in house arrest. People could meet him in his house. He preached to Jews living in Rome. He witnesses Jesus. He could win a lot of people in Ceaser's palace also.
