		They worshipped created beings, sun, moon, stars, animals, reptiles, rivers, hills, power in nature etc by making their idols.
4	What was condition of	They stood condemned and destined for punishment.
	gentiles in CH-1	Their minds got corrupted due to unnatural evil passions. So they lived in sin.
5	What was the guilt of Jews in CH-2	Jews could not live according to God's Holy Law which was given to them.  Jews stood condemned to receive punishment.
6	What is the good news in CH-3	Instead of punishing gentiles & Jews, God gave His only begotten Son as a sacrifice.
		Jesus Christ took our sins on Him. He took the punishment.
		We can get pardon for our sins by receiving Jesus Christ as Savior and Lord by Faith.

11	CH-7 - Warfare with Sin & Flesh	Jesus Christ pardoned our sins. He paid the ransom price. We are now children of God. But Sin tries to tempt and take control. Our flesh is very weak. The struggle is ongoing.
12	What is the result of the struggle.	St. Paul writes: Sometimes we cry " What a wretched man I am. Who will deliver me from this body of death". It is the cry of a Christian facing defeat.
13	CH-8 -What marvelous arrangement God made for our victory	When we accepted Jesus Christ as Savior God gave us His Holy Spirit.
		Holy Spirit helps us to live a victorious Christian life.
		What we need to do is just Surrender to the Holy Spirit.
14	What is the ministry of Holy Spirit	Holy Spirit living in us gives power to win against sin. We have victory over sin.
		Holy spirit prays for us. That is called Ministry of Intercession
		Holy Spirit's ministry is for our Sanctification (Holy Living)
